In English, we will be continuing with Jack and the Beanstalk. We will be thinking about adjectives, in particular thinking about how we can describe the castle, Jack and the Giant. We will also be describing some interesting objects, such as the old lantern we looked at a few weeks ago. If you have any old or intriguing objects, which you think the children may be interested in, please bring them in for us to describe.

In maths this week we will be focussing on both subtraction and addition – sometimes children can be secure with each skill of adding and taking away but find it more difficult when the calculations are mixed. So it is good to keep embedding these skills in many different contexts.

In Science we will be starting to think about humans as animals and in particular our senses. This week we will be focussing on sight. In PE, as it is only a few weeks until Sports Day we will start practicing running races this week.
