Malawi Day

On Tuesday 1st February we held our first 'Malawi Day'. This was the launch day of our partnership with Kaputu Primary School in Malawi. The day started with worship led by Cathy Penfold who is the School Links Co-ordinator from Starfish Malawi.

Throughout the day the children followed a range of activities. Russet Class listened to a traditional Malawian story of 'Kalulu the Lazy Hare'. They used the moral of the story of 'working together' to help them work collaboratively and problem solve how to cross the playground using planks and blocks only. Then they made starfish collages and learnt the 'Starfish Malawi' song.

Pippin Class made fact files and chose interesting information that they had learnt from both Cathy and by reading a range of texts to retrieve information. In the afternoon they made Malawian cookies using fair-trade ingredients and also learnt the 'Starfish Malawi' song.
