There are flower beds with a white and purple theme depicting the liturgical year as well as 4 stunning pictures representing the school's biblical story in which our vision is based upon, the Parable of the Sower.

The parable enables us all to remember the role and the responsibility we have ensuring that individually and collectively we are responsible for creating the very best 'growing' conditions within our school community so that everyone can indeed grow and flourish both academically and also as a unique human being.
