### Worship in Term 3

This term our focus in worship has been on exploring who Jesus is through the stories associated with the Epiphany and also through the 'I am' sayings of Jesus which are found in John's Gospel. E.g. It has provided a pause for wondering and reflection about Jesus' life and how his examples can continue to underpin the everyday life of our school. We have also been asking pupils to monitor worship answering questions such as:

What did you learn in worship today?

Will you do anything in response to what you have learnt about today?

If you had been leading worship, what might you have done differently?

How did worship make you feel today?

The results will then be used to inform future worship plans.
